Oshawa Public Libraries Introduces Brainfuse Homework Help

Back to school doesn't have to mean homework blues, now that students can easily access Brainfuse with their Oshawa Public Libraries membership!

Brainfuse is an online homework help service with professional tutors, for students from Kindergarten through Grade 12, with some post-secondary support. Live tutors are available daily to help with Math, Science, Reading, Social Studies, History, Geography, and Language Arts. Brainfuse also offers a writing lab to help students organize their writing structure, and an Adult Learners section for core skills building, and career resources.

Brainfuse is the second online educational tool to be implemented by Oshawa Public Libraries this year that fully support the Ontario school curriculum. Earlier in 2017, STEM Village was introduced to help make Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math, fun and accessible for kids and their families.
